#### **Project Description**

This project supports India's cleanest city of Indore, Madhya Pradesh in reducing emissions of 283,396 CO<sub>2</sub>e annually, the equivalent of taking 61,063 cars off the road for a year. Activities contributing to these reductions include composting to avoid landfill methane emissions and bio-methanation which converts organic material into biogas. The project also supports the development of grid-connected Solar PV which reduces reliance on fossil fuels for energy. Beyond emission reductions, the project maintains a multitude of initiatives which support Indore's community such as health check-ups, smart classrooms, and a women's center.
